A delicious, rounded English sparkler made from grapes grown in the named year. A fine aperitif.

2011 £62.50

A 100% Chardonnay sparkler. White gold in colour with hints of fresh bread and thyme on the nose.

Sparkling Rosé, Blackboys, East Sussex, England

2013 £66.50

A salmon pink wine with hints of blackberry and redcurrant. Produced in limited quantities.

Rathfinny Estate

Silky, round and ripe, this juicy Merlot is packed full of soft, red fruit and rich plum flavours. This wine is supple enough to drink alone but has enough structure to accompany food.

La Muse de Cabestanay, Pinot Noir, IGP Pays d’Oc 2021 £34.50
Complex aromas of black cherry, raspberry and cinnamon. Medium bodied, with dried fruit notes fresh red berries and sweet spice on the palate

La Combe de Grinou, Merlot-Cabernet, IGP Perigord 2020 £35.50
This is an alluring, soft and supple red blend. Light in colour, with smoky strawberry, crushed loganberry and dried herb notes, the wine is juicy and appealing. Very easy to drink.

Chateau La Grave de Bertin Cuvée, Bordeaux, Merlot 2019 £36.00
This Merlot has a very aromatic bouquet of ripe plum and fig fruits. The palate is dense, with rich tannins a long and smooth finish and very well-balanced.

Vignobles Gonnet, Côtes-du-Rhône 2020 £46.00
Beautiful, garnet red in colour with violet, chocolate and dried herb notes on the nose. More of the same on the palate, balanced perfectly with spicy liquorice, dark fruit and a fresh acidity. Rustic, yet elegant on the finish, this wine is exceptionally well made.

Domaine Lathuilière-Gravallon, Gamay, Beaujolais 2021 £48.00
Vibrant raspberry and red cherry aromas, with subtle floral notes. The core of pure red fruit and elegant tannins are complemented by violet spice and a fresh mineral finish. Juicy, fun and immensely pleasurable.

Château Lafon, Cru Bourgeois, Lustrac-Medoc 2016 £54.00
Rich and complex, it offers arrange of floral aromas, from violet to sweet peony, prunes, toast and vanilla. It has finely tannic elegance with a lingering and bright finish.

Château Saint Aubin, Cru Bourgeois, Médoc, Bordeaux 2018 £60.00
Rich and complex, it offers a range of floral aromas, from violet to sweet peony, prunes, toast and vanilla. It has finely tannic elegance with a lingering and bright finish.

Château Sichel, C&B Label, Margaux 2020 2020 £86.50
This is a bold and beautifully ripe Margaux. Darkly perfumed, with flavours of red berries, vanilla and spice, this is a delicious Bordeaux which is ready to enjoy now.

Sarget de Gruaud Larose, St Julien 2009 £92.50
With intense red and black fruit on the nose, the Sarget de Gruaud Larose is very supple, with smooth texture, deliciously juicy fruit on the palate and very fresh acidity. Beautifully ripe and very round, this displays an almost exotic spice character on the long, rewarding finish.

Bila-Haut, M.Chapoutier, Occultum Lapidem, Languedoc 2013 109.50
The first nose is quite closed with a dominant of graphitic, leather, and then intense aromas of pepper, black fruits and scrubs. The attack is rich and dense. Then the wine is fleshy and solar. The final is sappy served by delicate tannins and a great freshness.

Echo de Lynch Bages, Pauillac 2016 £122.50
Attractive dark berries with sweet, spicy oak that leads to a slick palate that delivers smooth tannins and a fresh, approachable finish.

Château Meyney, Cru Bourgeois, St Estèphe, Bordeaux 2012 £144.00
Classic St. Estèphe, dense and close-textured with smoky, jammy black cherry flavour and expansive fruit intertwined with liquorice and toasty oak nuances.

Château Beaugard, Pomerol, Bordeaux 2016 £184.00
Beaugard has a nose revealing complex aromas of blackcurrant, sweet spices and mint. The tannins are silky and smooth, and the wine has a long and mouth-watering finish.



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Louis Latour, Beaune 1^{er} Cru, Cote d’Or, Burgundy 2013 £196.00
Black cherry, liquorice and light oak with a suggestion of mocha dominate this elegant, full wine. Medium-to-full body with good tannins and extremely good balance.

Italy

Il Carretto, Rosso di Puglia IGT, Puglia 2020 £29.00
Intense ruby red colour, this Sangiovese displays spicy notes, together with fruit aromas of plums and red, crushed up, ripe berries.

Lucale, Appassimento, Primitivo, Puglia 2021 £36.50
Intense garnet red in colour, with a complex bouquet reminiscent of cherries, raspberries and redcurrants. The oak ageing adds a pleasant roasted and spicy aroma. Full-bodied, it is supple and well-balanced, with layers upon layers of dark fruit, fine tannins and a long and lingering finish.

Menegotti, Bardolino, Verona 2021 £41.00
Crunchy red fruit and sweet spices, classic Bardolino flavours. Made from indigenous grapes Corvina and Rondinella by family estate Menegotti.

La Tunella, Pinot Nero, Colli Orientali del Friuli 2020 £54.00
Distinct, characteristic bouquet with evident notes of raspberry and wild berries. A pleasant, dry and slightly aromatic palate, with a subtle bitter note and velvetiness.

La Tunella, Cabernet Franc, Colli Orientali del Friuli 2019 £54.00
The highly intense and elegant initial impact releases fruity and grassy notes. The scent spectrum ranges from red berries, such as wild black cherry, blackberry, and blackcurrant, through to the herbaceous flavour so characteristic of the variety, all set against a background of aged wood, barely perceptible.

Tenute Fiorebelli, Amarone della Valpolicella, Verona 2014 £78.00
This gorgeous Amarone has a lovely and intense dark garnet colour. It exudes aromas and flavours of black cherries, chocolate, coffee, and raisins, along with a note of almonds. Despite a formidable structure, the palate is velvety, spicy and elegant, with an extremely long and lingering finish.

Morellino Di Scansano, Tuscany 2004 £89.00
Traditional in style, rustic and full bodied. Sour sweet red fruit nose with a touch of star aniseed, spices, tobacco and white pepper. Leathery and firm after taste.

Morador, Tempranillo, Navarra 2021 £25.00
A brilliant red-garnet colour with clean and intense aromas of ripe cherry fruit develop in to a fresh palate of berry fruit with a delicate hint of vanilla.
