#### **Delamotte Champagne**

Champagne Delamotte's history stretches back over 250 years. It was founded in 1760 by vineyard owner François Delamotte, and as such is the fifth oldest house in the champagne region. Established from the outset in a beautiful residence in Le Mesnilsur-Oger, which houses its cellars and offices even today.

#### Brut, Le Mesnil-sur-Oger, France

This is a dry and extremely attractive champagne, balanced and elegant. They combine to give a wine of subtle power, appealing freshness, soft curves and a generous palate rich in orchard fruit.

#### Blanc de Blancs, Le Mesnil-sur-Oger, France

Simultaneously rich and delicate, the wine offers aromas of rose-petals, citrus, hints of ginger. On the palate, generous orchard fruit is laced with hints of brioche, a combination that has become Delamotte's hallmark.

#### **Laurent Perrier Champagne**

The House of Laurent-Perrier was founded in 1812 by André Michel Pierlot and took the name Vve Laurent-Perrier when Mathilde Emilie Perrier, the widow of Eugène Laurent, combined the two family names after she decided to expand the business.

#### La Cuvée, Brut, Champagne, France

Leaning towards a light style of Champagne, it is dominated with Chardonnay grapes bringing green apple notes and a citrus acidity.

#### Le Colture Prosecco

Santo Stefano di Valdobbiadene is a small village set in the vine-chequered mosaic of the Prosecco hills. Le Colture has grown wines here since the 1500s, under the guidance of the same family.

#### 'Sylvoz' DOC, Valdobbiadene, Italy
