Pale straw in colour with a delicate, fine mousse. The wine shows aromas and flavours of orchard fruit, citrus, almonds and white flowers, with a soft mousse and beautiful complexity of flavour on the palate.

Chapel Down, Rosé Brut, Tenterden, Kent, England

£9.80

A delicate rosé with aromas of ripe strawberries and raspberries with background notes of toasty shortbread.

Delamotte Brut, Le Mesnil-sur-Oger, Champagne, France

Sanziana Pinot Grigio Rosé, Banat, Romania

A salmon pink wine with hints of blackberry and redcurrant. Produced in limited quantities.

Established from the outset in a beautiful residence in Le Mesnil-sur-Oger, which houses its cellars and offices even today.

This thirst-quenching white wine displays aromas of nectarines, honeysuckle, almonds and tropical fruits together with floral notes.

Cecilia Beretta, Soave Classico, Veneto 2020 £40.50

Gently floral with ripe orchard fruit on the nose. The palate displays ripe peach, pear and citrus, with an almondy finish and creamy texture. Great aperitif or an extremely versatile food wine.

La Tunella, Ribolla Gialla, Colli Orientali del Friuli 2021 £52.50

An elegant and intense bouquet, floral, fruit and fragrant, with great class and consistency. The nose spans across notes of acacia, plum, yellow peach and green apple. The palate is intense and full with a supple body, echoing the varietal character. Dry, salty and pleasantly fresh.

Spain

Marqués de la Musa Garnacha Blanca Viura, Aragón 2020 £29.00

Pale in colour, this bright, aromatic and refreshing white bursts with delicate white peach character, white blossom, all enhanced by a zesty citrus tang. Ideal on its own, or to sublime food.

Pazo La Maza, Albariño, Rías Baixas 2021 £44.00

A young Albariño which packs a hefty citrus punch, the acidity making it very refreshing white. Perfect with fish and seafood.

Portugal

Quitta de Chocapalha, Arinto, Alenquer 2019 £38.50

Producing wines with a lightness of touch and refreshing aromatics, it is fresh and rippling with citrus and tropical fruits.

Austria

Crazy Creatures, Grüner Veltliner, Kremstal DAC 2020 £38.00

Only using the best grapes from the region, it is known for its spicy and herbal notes, yet fruity with fresh crisp finish.

Hungary

Egy Kis, Barta Wienry, Furmint, Tokaj 2021 £48.00

Refreshing pear and lime on the nose. The palate offers incredible purity of fruits, with flavour of yellow plum, green apple and lime accented with saline minerality.

Romania

Sanziana, Pinot Grigio, Banat 2020 £27.50

Opulent aromas of grapefruit and peach, with fresh flavours of melon, apple and zesty citrus.

South Africa

Lowry's Pass, Chenin Blanc, Western Cape 2021 £28.00

Pale-medium lemon in colour. The nose is open and aromatic with plenty of fresh citrus fruit. The palate is zingy and refreshing with grapefruit, lime and some nettle notes.

Nelson Estate, Sauvignon Blanc, Paarl 2021 £37.00

Bright, medium lemon in colour. Herbaceous notes on the nose with hints of green pepper. The palate shows green gage and yellow plum on entry, fleshing out on the mid-palate with some green nettle notes. The finish is vibrant with good, crisp acidity.



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New Zealand

Elephant Hill, Sauvignon Blanc, Hawke's Bay

Delicate aromas of citrus, gooseberry and fresh herbs. The palate shows juicy green apple, citrus and white peach flavours with a refreshing minerality.

England

The Bolney Estate, Lynchgate Red, West Sussex 2018 £38.00
A medium-bodied red wine with blackcurrant aromas and red berry on the palate.

France

Domaine St Estève, Merlot, IGP Pays d’OC, France 2020 £29.50
Silky, round and ripe, this juicy Merlot is packed full of soft, red fruit and rich plum flavours. This wine is supple enough to drink alone but has enough structure to accompany food.

La Muse de Cabestanay, Pinot Noir, IGP Pays d’Oc, France 2021 £30.00
Complex aromas of black cherry, raspberry and cinnamon. Medium bodied, with dried fruit notes fresh red berries and sweet spice on the palate

La Combe de Grinou, Merlot-Cabernet, IGP Perigord, France 2020 £33.00
This is an alluring, soft and supple red blend. Light in colour, with smoky strawberry, crushed loganberry and dried herb notes, the wine is juicy and appealing. Very easy to drink.

Vignobles Gonnet, Côtes-du-Rhône, France 2019 £39.50
Beautiful, garnet red in colour with violet, chocolate and dried herb notes on the nose. More of the same on the palate, balanced perfectly with spicy liquorice, dark fruit and a fresh acidity. Rustic, yet elegant on the finish, this wine is exceptionally well made.

Domaine Lathuilière-Gravallon, Gamay, Beaujolais, France 2021 £42.50
Vibrant raspberry and red cherry aromas, with subtle floral notes. The core of pure red fruit and elegant tannins are complemented by violet spice and a fresh mineral finish. Juicy, fun and immensely pleasurable.

Château Lafon, Cru Bourgeois, Lustrac-Medoc 2016 £52.00
Rich and complex, it offers arrange of floral aromas, from violet to sweet peony, prunes, toast and vanilla. It has finely tannic elegance with a lingering and bright finish.

Château Cantemerle, 5ème Cru Classé, Médoc, France 2009 £82.00
Soft and silky on the palate, generous, mulberry fruit and supple tannins. The fruit is well balanced by refreshing acidity, leading to a crisp, clean finish.

Château Cissac, Cru Bourgeois, Haut Médoc, France 1996 £87.00
Red garnet in the glass, with a very pleasant aroma of dark fruit and oak fig, black cherry and raspberry. Dark fruits on the palate with a mellow finish. Great with food or without.

Sarget de Gruaud Larose, St Julien, France 2009 £92.50
With intense red and black fruit on the nose, the Sarget de Gruaud Larose is very supple, with smooth texture, deliciously juicy fruit on the palate and very fresh acidity. Beautifully ripe and very round, this displays an almost exotic spice character on the long, rewarding finish.

Les Ormes de Pez, Cru Bourgeois, St. Estèphe, France 2005 £114.00
A spicy nose with notes of liquorice and pepper, this is an accessible wine with hints of cassis and tobacco. At once, classy, concentrated and quaffable, drinking well now.

Echo de Lynch Bages, Pauillac, France 2016 £122.50
Attractive dark berries with sweet, spicy oak that leads to a slick palate that delivers smooth tannins and a fresh, approachable finish.

Château d’Angludet, Cru Bourgeois, Margaux, France 2012 £137.50
A deep ruby colour, with a nose reminiscent of roasted meats, black truffles and liquorice. A medium to full bodied wine with black currant fruitiness.

Château Meyney, Cru Bourgeois, St Estèphe, Bordeaux, France 2012 £144.00
Classic St. Estèphe, dense and close-textured with smoky, jammy black cherry flavour and expansive fruit intertwined with liquorice and toasty oak nuances.

Château Beaugard, Pomerol, Bordeaux, France 2016 £184.00
Beaugard has a nose revealing complex aromas of blackcurrant, sweet spices and mint. The tannins are silky and smooth, and the wine has a long and mouth-watering finish.

Louis Latour, Beaune 1^{er} Cru, Cote d’Or, Burgundy, France 2013 £196.00
Black cherry, liquorice and light oak with a suggestion of mocha dominate this elegant, full wine. Medium-to-full body with good tannins and extremely good balance.



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Italy

Il Carretto, Rosso di Puglia IGT, Puglia, Italy 2020 £26.50
Intense ruby red colour, this Sangiovese displays spicy notes, together with fruit aromas of plums and red, crushed up, ripe berries.

Lucale, Appassimento, Primitivo, Puglia 2020 £36.50
intense garnet red in colour, with a complex bouquet reminiscent of cherries, raspberries and redcurrants. The oak ageing adds a pleasant roasted and spicy aroma. Full-bodied, it is supple and well-balanced, with layers upon layers of dark fruit, fine tannins and a long and lingering finish.

La Tunella, Pinot Nero, Colli Orientali del Friuli 2020 £52.50
Distinct, characteristic bouquet with evident notes of raspberry and wild berries. A pleasant, dry and slightly aromatic palate, with a subtle bitter note and velvetiness.

La Tunella, Cabernet Franc, Colli Orientali del Friuli 2019 £52.50
The highly intense and elegant initial impact releases fruity and grassy notes. The scent spectrum ranges from red berries, such as wild black cherry, blackberry, and blackcurrant, through to the herbaceous flavour so characteristic of the variety, all set against a background of aged wood, barely perceptible.

Tenute Fiorebelli, Amarone della Valpolicella, Verona, Italy 2014 £78.00
This gorgeous Amarone has a lovely and intense dark garnet colour. It exudes aromas and flavours of black cherries, chocolate, coffee, and raisins, along with a note of almonds. Despite a formidable structure, the palate is velvety, spicy and elegant, with an extremely long and lingering finish.

Morellino Di Scansano, Tuscany, Italy 2004 £89.00
Traditional in style, rustic and full bodied. Sour sweet red fruit nose with a touch of star aniseed, spices, tobacco and white pepper. Leathery and firm after taste.

Spain

50/50, Rioja Joven, Bodegas Zugoer, Rioja, Spain 2021 £32.00
Dark ruby with purple hues in colour. Clean and refreshing on the palate with intense red berries notes and a touch of liquorice. Fresh, fruity with soft tannins but yet characterful.

Vina Cerrada, Rioja Crianza, Rioja, Spain 2018 £37.00
Medium bodied with plum and classic vanilla from its aging in oak barrels.

Bodega Numanthia, Numanthia, Tempranillo, Toro, Spain 2016 £176.00
Numanthia is the estate's signature wine. Ripe cherry colour with ruby reflection, it is expressive and deep with hints red berries, smoky notes, garrigue aromas and a background of sweet spices. The velvety and mature tannin beautifully goes along with the generous and voluminous texture.

Lebanon

Château Musar, Bekaa Valley, Lebanon 2016 £77.00
A dark blood red colour with a rich, fragrant fruit nose; mulberries, black cherries, plums with a hint of mocha. A very intense and concentrated palate of forest and black fruits with elegant spice and soft tannins.

Romania

Sanziana, Merlot, Banat, Romania 2018 £27.50
Spiced plums and violets on the nose, with a soft and silky palate of juicy red cherries, raspberries and toasted notes.



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South Africa

Peaks View, Pinotage

Its fruit notes lean way over towards blackberry, plum, and black currant with earthy bramble in there.

Meerlust Estate, Red, Stellenbosch

Château Villa Bel-Air, Graves, France 2014 £97.00
A medium full-bodied wine full of generous earthy notes and vibrant red fruit. The palate is soft, with hints of strawberries and a touch of spice. Just beginning to burst deliciously into life.

A very well balanced and well rounded wine on the palate, that consists of cabernet sauvignon and merlot. With notes of cassis, cherries and earthwith firm tanins.

An attractive bouquet lightly roasted wood spice, and nicely concentrated black current fruit.

Plums, dark berries, cherries and medium tannins. Leather and black tea on the palate. Just reaching its peak and in need of a plate of roast beef or a piece of steak.

Two Hands, Shiraz, Barossa Valley, Australia 2006 £350.00
At 16½%, complex, expressive nose of spice box, scorched earth, plum, and blueberry. This is followed by mouth-filling, flavours of blue and black fruits, savoury flavours and an exceptionally long finish. Drink now.
