A modern Bordeaux with lots of concentrated fruit and an attractive, supple balance. Medium bodied with notes of jammy dark fruits, it has a long and elegant finish.

Château Villa Bel-Air, Graves, France 2014 £97.00
A medium full-bodied wine full of generous earthy notes and vibrant red fruit. The palate is soft, with hints of strawberries and a touch of spice. Just beginning to burst deliciously into life.

Hobbs, Shiraz, Barossa Valley, Australia 2006 £138.00
The 2006 Gregor Shiraz is made from fruit dried on trays in the style of Amarone. Deeply coloured, it has a liqueur, Port-like character to its aromas and flavours although it is dry. Notes of liquorice and chocolate and black fruits on the palate. Layered, balanced, and long.

Château Villars, Fronsac, France 1999 £144.00
A complex nose rich in matured red fruits, blueberries, oak and leather.

Château Xanadu, Cabernet Sauvignon, Margaret River, Australia 1991 £150.00
A Cabernet with integrated notes of cedar and incense and a coffee warmth to the black fruit character, which has been aged in French oak.

Louis Latour, Meursault Blanc, Bourgogne, France 1999 £155.00
A very well balanced burgundy, has aromas of peach and melon with some citrus that is well balanced by old oak.

Chateau Larose-Trintaudon, Cru Bourgeois, Haut Medoc, France 1984 £160.00
A very well balanced and well rounded wine on the palate, that consists of cabernet sauvignon and merlot. With notes of cassis, cherries and earthwith firm tanins.

Château Greysac, Cru Bourgeois, Medoc, France 1975 £180.00
An attractive bouquet lightly roasted wood spice, and nicely concentrated black current fruit.

Purple-coloured, this has an enticing perfume of balsam wood, lavender, incense, pepper, bacon and blueberry. An excellently balanced and smooth-textured, savoury Shiraz.

Deeply coloured and full bodied with lots of jam, plums, dark fruit with great notes of earth, meat, herbs and an old vine richness. Balanced and mature with a smooth, long finish. Drinking well now.

Plums, dark berries, cherries and medium tannins. Leather and black tea on the palate. Just reaching its peak and in need of a plate of roast beef or a piece of steak.

At 16½%, complex, expressive nose of spice box, scorched earth, plum, and blueberry. This is followed by mouth-filling, flavours of blue and black fruits, savoury flavours and an exceptionally long finish. Drink now.

Château Musar, Bekaa Valley, Lebanon 2010 £425.00
